- 5. What kind of space do they require for a dental visit?
- 6. How many students can they see in a day?
- 7. What is their referral process for students who need additional follow-up care?
- 8. Do other schools in my building already have a dental provider?

Dental Services Cheat Sheet

Services	Definition
Preventive Services	
Dental Examination	A visual assessment of the mouth
Prophylaxis	Dental cleaning
Topical Fluoride	A topical coating applied on all teeth which helps prevent tooth decay by up to 42%
Silver Diamine Fluoride	Arrests the progress of existing tooth decay and can also prevent formation of new cavities
Sealants	A thin protective coating applied to the back teeth which helps prevent tooth decay by up to 80%
X-Ray	Images of the mouth taken to assess cavities and tooth development that are not visible through the visual assessment

Restorative Care	Treatment of tooth decay
