Roles	<b>DECE Special Education Coordinator</b> supports all classrooms at Pre-K Centers to identify and serve preschool students with disabilities (*Classrooms opened prior to the onboarding of DECE Special Education Coordinators are supported by an SEO Special Education Preschool Specialist).	<b>District School PK-5 Special Education Team.</b> School administrators are responsible for ensuring special education needs are met in all classes. In addition, school-based staff such as special education liaison, assistant principal, IEP coordinator, etc. support early childhood special education needs in their buildings; in addition the B/CO Special Education Director is a resource and can identify other staff and resources for additional support.
